Our Dynamic Support Keyworkers work with:

- Autistic people.
- People with a learning disability.

Why do we have Dynamic Support Keyworkers?

- They make sure that people and their families/carers get the right support at the right time from education, health and social care.
- They aim to reduce admissions to mental health hospitals and support discharge.

What do people say about us?

Things have started happening since you have been involved as you keep on top of communication with everyone, and we are kept in the loop with everything.

> They put the children and young people's goals and wishes at the centre of their work.

Who can have a Dynamic Support Keyworker?

Our service can support you if you are:

- Aged between 0 25 (if you are aged 18 or over allocation of a Dynamic Support Keyworker will focus on transition from children and adult services).
- On the Dynamic Support Register as either Red, Amber or Blue (inpatient). People who are identified as Green may receive advice and information.
- Have a GP in North Yorkshire, York, Hull, East Riding, North Lincolnshire or North-East Lincolnshire.



Dynamic Support Keyworkers help by:

LISTENING

• Listening to you and sharing your thoughts and feelings.

ACTING

- Working with services to try and unblock barriers and achieve change.
- Making sure care continues once Dynamic Support Keyworker support is no longer needed.
- Being the main point of contact for people and their families.

DOING

- Creating a plan with you about what matters to you.
- Helping to make sure that you get the right care.
- Planning for you to live in the community with the right support.
